Structural adjustment of agriculture was pushed steadily. The ration of the value-added of agriculture, forestry, animal husbandry and fishery was 55.2:6.5:31.9:6.4. The ration of the value-added of animal husbandry accounted for the primary industry was 2.0 percentage points higher over the previous year. In 2004, the sown areas of grain was 5.07 million hectares, imcreased 0.54 million hectares, up by 11.9 percent. Of which, the sown areas of high quality rice increased 37.3 percent, covered 47.9 percent of that of the rice; it was 8.5 percentage points higher over the previous year. The sown areas of oil-bearing crops was 867.6 thousand hectares, increased by 1.1 percent. The sown areas of cotton was 142.1 thousand hectares, increased by 2.3 percent . The sown areas of vegetables was 962.5 thousand hectares, decreased by 0.2 percent.

Quick progress was seen in animal husbandry . The value-added of animal husbandry was 36.9 billion yuan, increased 5.8 percent over the previous year. The number of slaughtered fattened hogs amounted to 70.4 million heads, up by 5.7 percent. The number of slaughtered beef cattle was 1.85 million heads, up by 10.0 percent. The number of slaughtered sheep and goats was 7.91 million heads, increased by 9.5 percent. The total output of meat for the year reached 5.96 million tons, up by 6.1 percent. The output of poultry and eggs was 0.88 million tons, up by 2.7 percent. The output of cow milk was 0.07 million tons, up by 26.8 percent. Steady progress was seen in fishery. The value-added of fishery was 7.4 billion yuan, up by 5.3 percent. The total output of aquatic products was 1.67 million tons, up by 6.8 percent.
