

guaranteed by water-saving irrigation system. The total power of agricultural machinery reached 29.25 million kw, up by 9.8 percent.

New progress was gained in helping people out of poverty. In 2004, the fund in helping people out of poverty reached 1.23 billion yuan, and 0.212 million people have solved the problem of adequate food and clothing and acrossed the line of low income. In the whole province, there are 2171 Drinking Water Projects established, helping 246,700 persons out of the difficulty in drinking water, 304,500 methane tanks made in the countryside, 141 village and township clinics established in poor areas, and 11,800 poor people having solved the housing problem.

III. Industry and Construction

Fast growth was registered in industrial production. In 2004, the total value-added of the industrial sector was 178.11 billion yuan, up by 15.9 percent over the previous year. The value-added of the industrial enterprises above designated size was 119.81 billion yuan, increased by 24.1 percent. Of which, the value-added of "10 advantaged industries" (including equipment manufacturing, steel and colored, cigarette and foodstuffs, electron information and newly materials) was 91.2 billion yuan, up by 26.5 percent. The value-added of "10 typified industrial enterprises" reached 39.12 billion yuan, increased by 28.8 percent, leading the industria enterprises above designated size increase 8.7 percentage points.

Energy production and production of major raw materials speeded up. The total output of primary energy reached 31.46 million tons of standard coal equivalent, it was up by 14.9 percent over the previous year. The electricity generated for the whole year was 60.52 billion kilowatt-hours, up by 16.8 percent. The output of coal was 30.36 million tons, up by 18.5 percent. The value-added of the smelting and pressing of ferrous metals was up 55.8 percent over the previous year; that of the nonferrous metals was up 21.5 percent; that of the raw chemical materials and chemical products and that of non-metal mineral products was up 41.0 and 21.4 percent respectively. Among major raw material products, the output of crude steel stood at 8.04 million tons, up by 36.5 percent; that of rolled steel was 8.02 million tons, up by 36.6percent. The production of 10 kinds of nonferrous metals went up by 8.3 percent; that of sulfuric acid increased 18.5 percent; that of cement increased 10.7 percent; that of ferroalloy increased 36.0 percent.
